



Kids That Go Fees Schedule

The following fees are subject to change at the discretion of Kids That Go.

NOTE: If you have Private Health Extras, please check with your insurer to see if you are eligible for a rebate. Most services do not attract a rebate from Medicare. Only children with an Enhanced Primary Care/Chronic Disease Management Plan (EPC/CDMP) from their GP can access a Medicare rebate (up to 5 sessions per calendar year). The child must be in attendance of the appointment to be eligible for a CDMP rebate.

Late Cancellation Fee	(< 24 hours notice given)	\$ 75
